



# XP2 Class 1: Sewing

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### Overview:

Experience the New Luminaire 2 Innov-is XP2 sewing and embroidery machine with the overview of included accessories and top sewing features. Piece a quilt block using the XP2's sewing features such as projecting a guideline marker for a ¼" seam and try the New Magnifying Lens, an optional accessory, to see the needle in finer detail. Sew along to learn about the new End Point Sewing Mode on the XP2 for stitch precision even with decorative stitching. Plus get an overview of the XP1 Upgrade Kit 2 which includes the new End Point Sewing feature.

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## Kit

- Three colors of quilt weight cotton fabric (see separate Pre-work cutting instructions)
- Tear away stabilizer (Pre-work: cut piece 20" x 18" to support block for decorative stitching)

## Other Supplies

- White Thread (ETP001) for piecing and decorative stitching
- White bobbin thread (SAEBT) (Brother pre-wound PWB250)
- Organ sewing needles (SASEW8012)
- Battery for Stylus (1 AAA)
- Basic sewing supplies: Scissors, seam ripper, pins
- Glue Stick (optional)
- Iron and pressing surface

## Machine set up

- Sewing Mode with Wide Table

## Pre-Work Cutting

Turquoise Fabric:

- Four 8" x 4¼" rectangles
- One 2¾" square

Coral Fabric:

- Four 4¼" squares
- Two 5¼" squares – cut in half on the 45° diagonal, yielding four triangles

Gray Fabric:

- One 5" square

(Tip: You can also starch the fabric for stable decorative stitching)
